



From 2 litres to 38 litres of milk per day! â?? A story of Githunguri

## Description

In June 2022, a diaspora based client visited his dairy farm in Kieni East, Nyeri County â?? Kenya and was shocked by the poor condition of his herd. He remembered about a peer who also lives abroad and has a farm in Bungoma County whom [Dairyverse](#) team had worked with in revival of production in his farm. 


Has your costly cow depreciated in value? Bought @Kes. 200K and can only fetch @Kes. 50K & milk yield is not promising?



Gradual improvement in body condition and yields took place and milk yield reached a high of 15 litres per day for the better part of her pregnancy/incalf state. She was dried off at a production of 8 litres per day.
